



## Shabbat Programming Policy

### Honoring Shabbat

- Shabbat programming will include a recognition of Shabbat, such as serving challah and juice for snack, reading a Shabbat book, singing Shabbat songs, etc.
- The program description will be clearly communicated so families can determine if the program fits with their Shabbat practice
- There will be “Shabbat-friendly” options that work for everyone (such as stickers/Play-doh, etc.) if there is cutting or coloring included.

### Photo and Video

- Photos/video may be taken if participants are comfortable.
- Posting on social media will be done after Shabbat

### Program Timing

- In an effort not to compete with synagogue morning programming such as Tot Shabbat, Saturday programs will take place during the afternoon vs. the morning

### Staff

- Shabbat programming is an optional choice; Staff is not required to lead programming on Shabbat
